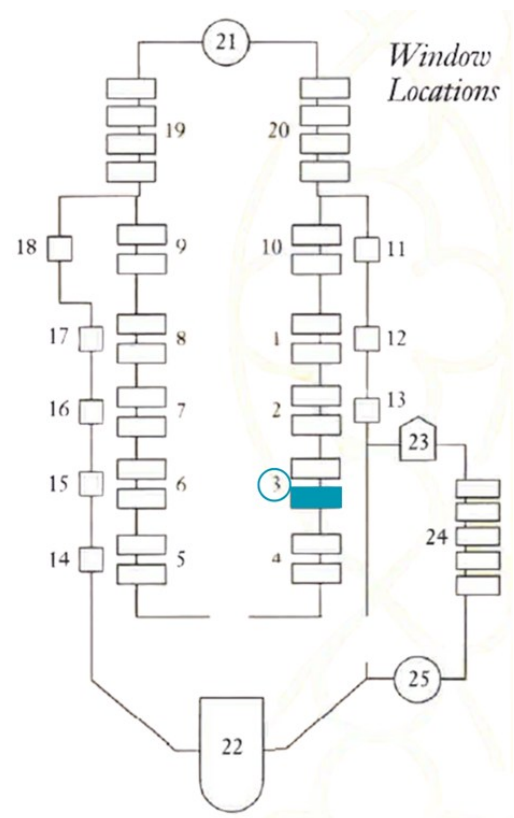

**Bulletin Cover**—Facing the chancel on the right wall, the window (#3) illustrating the public ministry of Jesus is composed of two lancets. The bulletin cover depicts the center medallion in the right lancet. Here, the disciples of Jesus are asking, "Lord teach us to pray." Jesus responds with the Lord's Prayer.

**Communion**—Communion today is by intinction. Exit your pew via the center aisle and come forward to the front, receiving the bread from the server and dipping it in the cup. Alternatively, individual elements are available. After you have been served, return to your seat via the outside aisle.
